- The quality of the classroom experience, which is informed by regular reviews of teaching and learning at the school and underpinned by accurate self-evaluation and effective planning.
- The strength of relationships within the school community and the world beyond, including our tolerance, respect, and understanding of each other.
- The confidence and self-belief of our pupils, and their resilience to the difficulties and challenges they may encounter in life.
- The numbers acquiring the wider knowledge and cultural capital they need to succeed in life, demonstrated, in part, through the range, variety and success of our curriculum enrichment programmes, and breadth, depth and uptake of our co-curricular offering.
- The appropriateness and quality of the destinations of our school leavers, including the success of their transition to the next stage of their education, training, or employment.
